

The Preschool and School Aged Children Hearing Checklist

It is important to observe your child for any signs of potential hearing loss.

Does your child...

- Turn up the volume of the TV excessively high?
- Respond inappropriately to questions?
- Not reply when you call him/her?
- Watch others to imitate what they are doing?
- Have articulation problems or speech / language delays?
- Have problems academically?
- Have difficulty with reading and spelling skills?
- Complain of earaches, ear pain or head noises?
- Have difficulty understanding what people are saying?
- Seem to speak differently from other children his or her age?

While these signs don't necessarily mean that your child has a hearing problem, they could be indicators of one.
